

**BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION:**

Batteries are small objects. Replacement of batteries must be done by adults. Follow the polarity (+/-) diagram in the battery compartment. Promptly remove dead batteries from the toy. 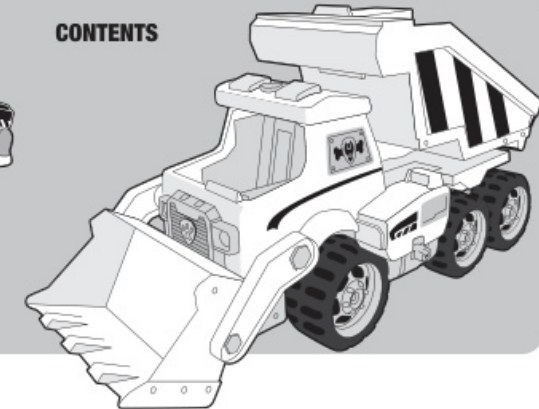

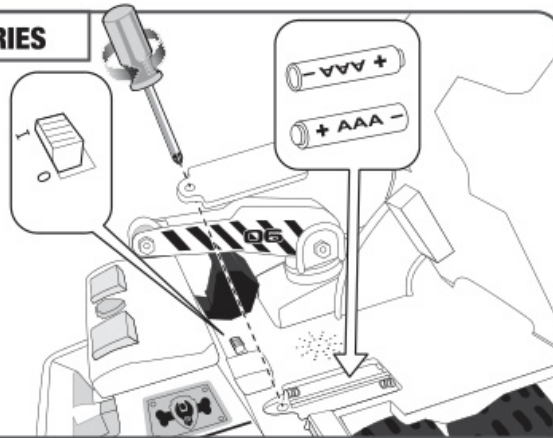

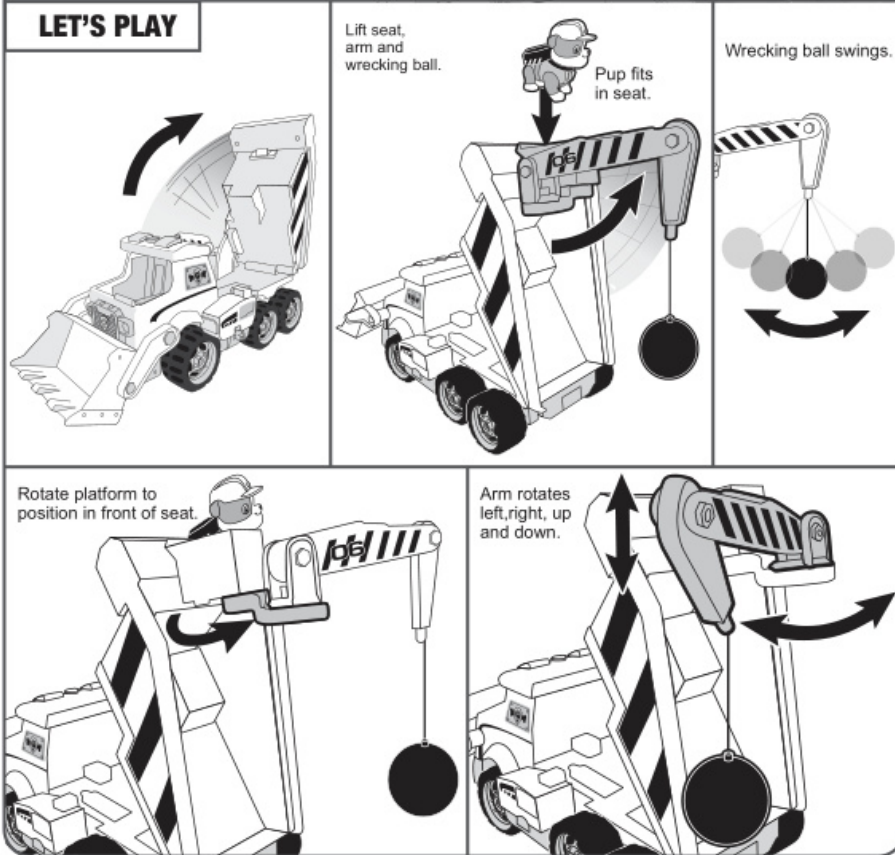

## HOW TO INSTALL BATTERIES

4. Replace battery door securely.

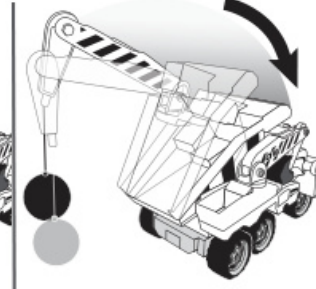

## RESET ARM & BALL

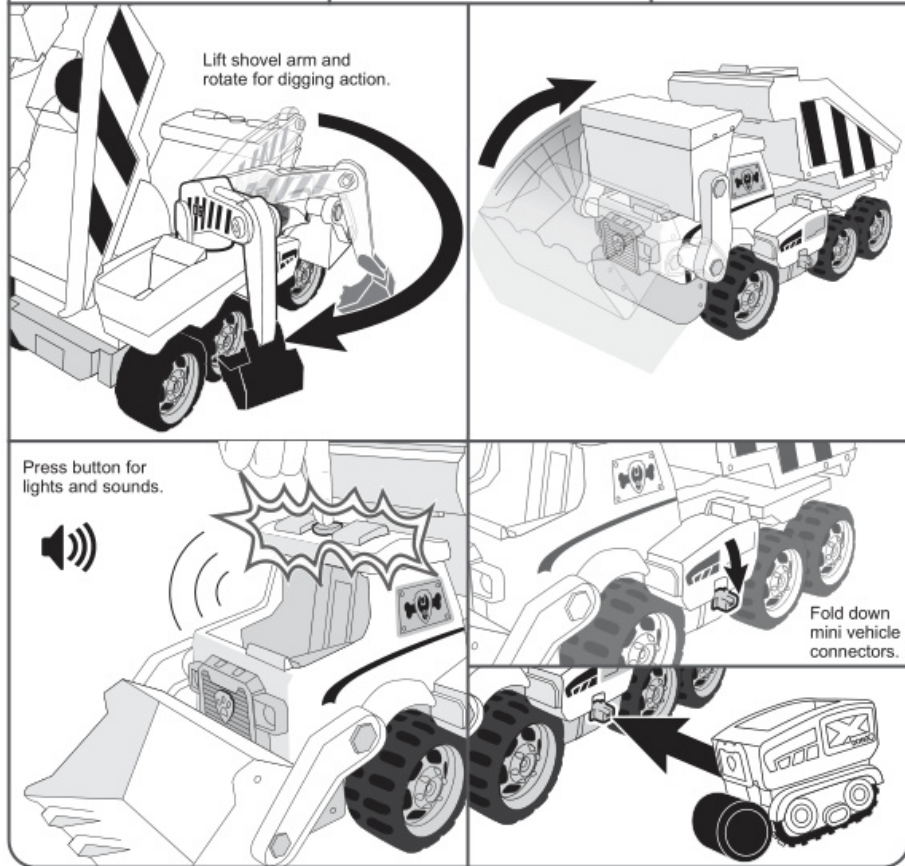
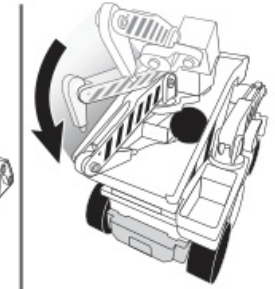
- 1 Rotate arm behind seat as shown.
