




### **BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

 HOW TO INSTALL BATTERIES: 1. Open the battery door with a screwdriver. 2. If used batteries are present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery. DO NOT remove or install batteries using sharp or metal tools. 3. Install new batteries as shown in the polarity diagram (+/-) inside the battery compartment. 4. Replace battery door securely.

5. Check your local laws and regulations for correct recycling and/or battery disposal.

MARNING: KEEP BATTERIES OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. This product contains a Button or Coin Cell Battery. A swallowed Button or Coin Cell Battery can cause internal chemical burns in as little as two hours and lead to death due to chemical burns and potential perforation of the esophagus.
